



DUBLIN PUBLIC SAFETY MEMORIAL



SEPTEMBER 11, 2005 UNVEILING

The Dublin Public Safety Memorial was unveiled and became a reality on September 11, 2005 serves as a tribute to those Public Safety members who made the ultimate sacrifice in the line of duty in Dublin, as well as a tribute to the Public Safety personnel that serve our community each and every day. It also serves as an inspiration to those who follow in their footsteps. The Memorial, designed by Brodin Studios, is a free standing bronze sculpture with four separate figures, consisting of a Deputy Sheriff and Firefighter, each holding the hand of a small child. The sculpture is titled "The Protectors" and is located in the center courtyard at the Dublin Civic Center.

As you get close enough to see the detail in the sculpture, you will also notice the plaques and engravings on the sides and tops of the concrete benches. These engravings provide a way to memorialize a loved one or demonstrate your business or personal support to the memorial.

If you are interested in having your inscription placed on the bench (the Dublin Public Safety Memorial Committee will be adding more engravings in time for Christmas 2005), please complete the Donor Engraving Form below. For a donation of \$100, your inscription will be engraved on top of one of the two concrete benches. Those who contribute \$1,000 or more will be recognized on plaques installed on the sides of the concrete benches.
